



NOTES:

- Driveways typically shall be constructed with a crown to provide drainage control.
- Driveways constructed across a slope shall be pitched to drain toward the downhill side of the slope.
- Driveways with an uphill slope from the road shall not be used as a drainageway for driveway turnaround runoff or roof spout runoff.
- No paving of any driveway is permitted until the Township has inspected the site and has issued a permit for that purpose.
- (1) A request for relief from the Minimum Stopping Sight Distance requirement shall be accompanied by all the information required under Section 3.1E.
