Mr. Spohn called the Greenwich Township Regular Meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and asked everyone to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

NEW BUSINESS:

2026 Budget Workshop

Revenue changes of note:

Real Estate Transfer Tax is expected to increase significantly due to the sale of the four properties associated with the GLC Lehigh Valley Warehouse Project. Earned Income Tax has also been increasing and that budget number has been increased accordingly.

Expense changes of note:

The library has increased funding. The Board agreed to increase the donation to \$3,725. A part time snowplow driver was discussed. Due to the increase in health care costs, there will be no salary increase for any employee. The Board agreed to increase paid time off by eight hours each year for years 1 through 5 of an employee's tenure.

The Gun Club Road Bridge was discussed. No word has been received on grant funding. The Board earmarked \$500,000 from the PLGIT account in the budget and used excess funds from this year for special engineering for the project in 2026. The new truck is expected soon. The truck payment will be taken from the General Fund instead of State Liquid Fuels since the payment exceeds the amount the township can spend on equipment.

The Board asked that the changes be made for the December 1st meeting where the budget will be reviewed and authorized for advertising.

Having no further business, Mr. Spohn adjourned the regular meeting at 8:50 a.m.
